ORDER

As per government order read as 2nd paper above, Government have prescribed the norms for relief assistance to the victims from State Disaster Response Fund to the victims of natural calamities . As per the letter read as 3rd paper above, the Ministry of Home Affairs has revised the norms 1(e) in respect of Gratuitous Relief for families whose livelihood is seriously affected and who are not housed in the Relief camps, as under:

Sl.No.	Items	Existing	Revised
1(e)	Gratuitous Relief for families whose livelihood is seriously affected	Rs.60/- per adult and Rs 45/- per child	Rs.100/- per adult and Rs.60/- per child

Besides existing terms and conditions, Ministry of Home Affairs has added following conditions for the revised rate of Gratuitous Relief.

- Expenditure on this account shall not exceed 25% of the SDRF allocation for the year;
- To avoid duplication of benefits in a geographical unit (village/colony).
Gratuitous Relief as per S.No.1(e) of the list of items and norms shall not be provided to those persons who are housed in relief camps;
- Gratuitous Relief shall be credited to the bank account of the beneficiaries through DBT mechanism using PFMS or a State DBT portal;
- To ensure transparency, the list of persons to whom Gratuitous Relief is

- provided should be uploaded on the website of the State Government and
- v. The State Government shall notify the basis and process for identification of beneficiaries district wise in a transparent manner.

Accordingly Government are pleased to amend the item 1(e) of the Annexure to the Government order read as 2nd paper above and follow the above norms in respect of gratuitous Relief for families whose livelihood is seriously affected and who are not housed in the Relief camps.
