INTRODUCTION

Harnessing the human spirit is central to Disaster resilience and Preparedness. The common man bears the biggest brunt and is the first responder in the face of disaster. With the knowledge of local geology, hazard context and the livelihood options available, the local community should be involved in disaster risk resilience and preparedness processes. If the people are trained in advance, they can work in tandem with the Government to efficiently manage any disaster.

Kerala set an example for the world with our strength of volunteerism during the recent climate and health crises including floods and Covid-19 pandemic. Moved by this immense response of the civil society, the Government decided to form the **Directorate of Samoohika Sannadhasena** also called Community Volunteer Corps, under the Department of General Administration for sustaining volunteerism as an asset of Kerala society. First of its kind in India, **Samoohika Sannadhasena** was conceptualized as a ready to act community volunteer force in all crises of the society.

The changing nature of crises has necessitated the need to equip this volunteer force with requisite skills of disaster risk resilience and preparedness. The government entrusted the Chief Executive Officer (CEO), District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA) as the District Nodal Officer, Samoohika Sannadhasena and proposed to conduct a Disaster Risk Resilience & Preparedness in all 14 Districts by DDMAs by covering a minimum 1000 Sannadha Sena Volunteers in each district.

As per this direction, Disaster Risk Resilience & Preparedness training was carried out by DDMA Ernakulam for **1161 volunteers** in **9 sessions**; 7 sessions for the Taluks, 1 for Cochin Corporation and a separate targeted training session for ASHA (Accredited Social Health Activist) workers.

PLANNING STAGE

A meeting was held on 20.10.2022 with Cochin Corporation Secretary, Deputy Director of Panchayats (DDP), Regional Joint Director (RJD), Urban Affairs, District Medical Officer(DMO) and District Fire Officer(DFO) to discuss the training schedule, course of action and identification of resource persons for the training.

A Google form was prepared to procure the list of 10 volunteers each from all 82 Panchayats, 15 volunteers each from all 13 Municipalities and 2 each from all 74 wards of Kochi Municipal Corporation.

E-mails attached with the aforesaid form were disbursed to all Panchayat and Municipal Secretaries to procure the list of volunteers from their respective local bodies. The list of volunteers received were then sorted Taluk- wise and that list was sent to the respective Taluks. A meeting was held on 04.11.2022 by the Deputy Collector (Disaster Management) with the Deputy Director of Panchayat, Regional Joint Director, Urban Affairs, all Local Body Secretaries to ensure participation of all volunteers from the given list.

Another meeting was held on the same date for all Tahsildars by the Deputy Collector (Disaster Management) to provide guidelines for Taluk wise training sessions.

The Ernakulam District ASHA coordinator was consulted regarding conducting a separate training session for Asha Workers.

The Directorate of Samoohika Sannadhasena organized a meeting for all DDMAs in the State.

All the members of the District Emergency Operations Centre (DEOC) team were actively involved throughout the planning and implementation process.

FEATURES OF TRAINING IN ERNAKULAM

2.1 TARGETED CATEGORIES

A. Local Sannadhasena volunteers in the Taluk

Volunteers from all Local Bodies attended the training. A brief interaction of these volunteers to get to know each other was organized at the end of each training session. The Taluk- wise Whatsapp groups also provide a platform for them to build a rapport and work together in any emergency situation in the future.

B. Youth from colleges in the Taluk limits

It is imperative to shape a **socially responsible and empathetic youth volunteer force** who can work in tandem with the Government during any crisis. **Select students from colleges from each Taluk** were identified as a target group for training. Actively participating in all demonstrations and asking relevant questions, the young volunteers made all the training sessions highly interactive.

C. ASHA workers

As front line workers who have proved their mettle by tirelessly ensuring the last mile delivery of health services, **equipping them with skills for disaster preparedness** is the need of the hour.

185 ASHA workers from coastal local bodies across the district were thus provided training in a **separate programme held exclusively for them**. They were also enjoined to spread awareness about Samoohika Sannadhasena in their respective localities.

2.2 PROMOTION THROUGH SOCIAL MEDIA

A separate google form was created for social media respondents and posted along with the notice. Around 72 responses were received in a span of two days and the respondents attended the inaugural training.

Updates of the Taluk trainings were also posted on the District Collector's Facebook page which garnered increased attention

from the public resulting in **more spot registrations** for subsequent training sessions.

2.3 HELP DESK AT VENUES

Registration desks were arranged at each training center to help participants with registration.

Spot registration was done for those who had not previously registered on the Samoohika Sannadhasena portal.

Officers from all Taluks were instructed to be present at the inaugural session held at the Collectorate Conference Hall to understand the registration procedure and replicate the same at the Taluks.

A **manual registration sheet template** was provided to the Taluks beforehand. These manual sheets were kept on each desk for entering the name and details of all attendees for cross-checking before issuing the certificate. **Separate Help desks** were arranged by DDMA for the confirmation of participation on the website and for **issuing certificates to each participant**, at the venue itself.

2.4 WHATSAPP GROUPS

Whatsapp groups have been created for each Taluk and Kochi Corporation for speedy dissemination of information, early warnings and to facilitate the coordination of volunteers.

With DDMA as the admin on these groups, **any clarification regarding downloading the e-certificate** could be promptly cleared. For those who required further guidance, certificates were downloaded and shared personally.

The groups can act as a medium for the **District Disaster Management Authority to communicate with the volunteers** and seek their cooperation in emergency situations.

A sense of camaraderie shall be built among the volunteers belonging to the same Taluk through interaction in these groups.

2.5 GREEN PROTOCOL

Banners for all sessions were printed **on cloth** instead of plastic. Refreshments were provided to volunteers in **steel glasses & plates. Eco-friendly paper files** & stationery were provided to all participants

2.6 INVOLVEMENT OF ELECTED REPRESENTATIVES

All MLAs and MPs of Ernakulam District were officially informed about the training programme and invited to attend the inaugural session as well as those held within their constituency limits.

2.7 TARGETED TRAINING FOR ASHA WORKERS

ASHA workers from 20 identified Panchayats, 2 municipalities and Cochin Corporation **residing in disaster prone coastal regions** were provided Disaster Risk Resilience and Preparedness training. As frontline health activists who are strongly linked to the last mile of the society, equipping ASHA workers with Disaster Risk Reduction and Preparedness Training will empower them to **pass on the knowledge to the local communities.**

All the participants were **actively engaged** in the training session and asked pertinent doubts and questions to the trainers.

2.8 HELPLINE NUMBERS

District Emergency Operations Centre (DEOC) helpline numbers were provided to all participants for further enquiries. **Certificates were downloaded and shared personally via WhatsApp** to those who sought guidance for the same.



2.9 CONTRIBUTION OF DEOC TEAM

A proactive and efficient team led by **Smt.Usha Bindumol**, Deputy Collector Disaster Management worked painstakingly to successfully complete the training for 1161 volunteers. The training sessions were meticulously planned and organized by **Anjaly Parameshwaran**, Hazard Analyst and **Leela Jerard Kurian**, YKIP intern, Kerala Youth Leadership Academy. They were supported by **Aishwarya S.**, LSGD DM Coordinator and **Jai Jacob**, DEOC coordinator.

Local Community Mobiliser of National Cyclone Risk Mitigation Project (NCRMP) **Deepu K Uthaman** prepared eye-catching posters, assisted with registration and setting up at each training venue.

Three interns of DDMA **Aswathy C M**, **Jayalakshmi K B** and **Priya Mohan** were actively involved in all stages of implementation and documentation of the training.

The officials from Fire & Rescue, Police and Revenue at DEOC also helped in preparing the training material and clarifying doubts of volunteers who contacted the official number.



TRAINING SESSIONS

3.1 INAUGURAL SESSION

The inaugural training programme was held in the Collectorate conference hall Ernakulam on 05.11.2022.

The first session on Fire & Rescue which was conducted by Thrikkakara fire and rescue officer N P Nissam assisted by Paul Shaji Antony. It was an interactive session wherein types of fires were discussed and live demonstrations on the usage of fire extinguishers were provided.

Since the sessions were scheduled till evening, lunch was provided to all the participants.

After lunch, Medical and First aid training was conducted by the Ernakulam Medical College Nursing Superintendent Anupama U. The session included demonstration of Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), first aid remedies of choking, drowning and snake poisoning.

This was followed by a session on the basics of Disaster Management by Anjaly Parameswaran, Hazard Analyst, DDMA Ernakulam.

In conclusion, a session on 'Volunteerism' and 'Being the First Responder in a Disaster' was taken by Leela Jerard Kurian, Kerala Youth Leadership Academy (KYLA) representative.

Active participation could be seen from the volunteers in all these sessions.

The inaugural session was successfully completed with a total of 148 participants and e-certificates were issued to all.
