## Brief report on WHO team visit at KSDM, KSEOC on 25<sup>th</sup> Sept 2023

In connection with the two days' programme on National Orientation Meeting on Drowning Prevention organized by WHO India, 'Drowning prevention and emergency response in Kerala' was one of the major sessions in that programme. Mr. Sathyakumar C J, Hazard Analyst invited them to handle this this session.

Despite the session being originally scheduled at the venue, the WHO team made a deliberate choice to visit the Kerala State Disaster Management Authority (KSDMA) to gain deeper insights into its functions and understand the initiatives being implemented to mitigate drowning deaths. Comprising 50 individuals, the team visited the Kerala State Emergency Operations Center (KSEOC) where they were greeted by Dr. Sekhar L Kuriakose, Member Secretary of KSDMA. Dr. Kuriakose extended a warm welcome to the team and delivered a comprehensive speech, providing an overview of all activities carried out by KSDMA in disaster mitigation and response.

Hazard Analyst Sri. Sathyakumar C J explained the WHO team about the functions of the Fusion Center and conducted a detailed presentation for the team about the initiatives taken by KSDMA to minimize drowning deaths in Kerala.

By the end of the presentation, conducted short film show titled 'Nerrivu', which produced by KSDMA as part of drowning prevention campaign. The short film got a good feedback from the participants as well.
