

Event Name	Fire Mock Drill
Event date	15-03-2024
Event venue	JD LSGD Building, Civil Station Malappuram
Details of the event	A fire simulation exercise was conducted at the civil station in collaboration with the District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA) and the Fire Force department. The objective was to raise awareness about the increasing temperatures and the potential for fire incidents in the district. The drill included participation from 10 personnel from the Fire Force department, 5 from Civil Defense, as well as liaison officers from the health and police departments. To facilitate the response, a single fire engine and ambulance were deployed. The mock drill was held at the Collectorate, with approximately 80 participants, including members of the public. During the simulation, a fire broke out in dried leaves near the JD LSGD building. As smoke filled the building, alarms were activated, prompting both the public and officers to evacuate via the stairs and assemble at designated safe points. This scenario was part of the mock drill. Following the exercise, the CEO DDMA and JD LSGD addressed the participants.
