ORDER

The State was exposed to natural disaster of substantive proportions, with tidal waves (Tsunami) hitting the Kerala coastline on 26th December 2004, which killed over 170 persons and caused extensive damage on long stretches of the coastline. Its impact the scale of which far surpassed disaster events in recent periods of known history, has evoked the need for highly organised efforts for relief and rehabilitation and also advance efforts for natural disaster reduction. These tasks need to be organised in a comprehensive manner and would require interactive planning and also coordination with research institutions and other agencies for effective natural disaster reduction.

- In the above background, government have decided to set up a
 Department of Disaster Management to be headed by a Secretary to
 government and they order accordingly.
- 3. The Disaster Management Department will be under the control of the Revenue Department of the Secretariat and Secretary, Disaster Management Department will report to Minister in charge of Revenue.
