<u>ORDER</u>

As per the Government order read as 1st paper above, Government have issued guidelines for the utilization of PM CARE Fund. As per the letter read as 2nd paper above, Government of India informed that if State have any balance fund left out of the amount released from PM Cares fund, which cannot be used anymore for the eligible activities, ie, providing food, accommodation, medical and transport to the migrant labourers, then they may be allowed to use the funds for expenses already incurred in the above mentioned activities. However, all such States are required to give an undertaking that double booking of expenditure has not been done and that States should be able to provide list of group of migrants given benefit with details of name, address, mobile number etc. for each of the activities, ie, accommodation, food, medical treatment and transportation. As per the letter read as 3rd paper above, Member secretary, Kerala State Disaster Management Authority requested to revise the guideline of the usage of PM CARE Fund as instructed by GOI.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to revise the guideline of PM CARE Fund approved vide G O read as 1st paper above as follows:

"If Districts have any balance fund left out of the amount released from PM Cares fund, which cannot be used anymore for the eligible activities i.e providing food, accommodation, medical and transport to the migrant labourers, then they are allowed to use the funds for expenses already incurred in the above mentioned activities. All such Districts are required to give an undertaking to Kerala State Disaster Management Authority that double booking of expenditure has not been done and that Districts should be able to provide list of group of migrants given benefit with details of name, address, mobile number etc. for each of the activities, i.e accommodation, food, medical treatment and transportation".
