ORDER

Government as per GO read above have accorded permission to Member Secretary , KSDMA to sign an agreement with UNDP in connection with a project funding support i.e, for supporting Rs.15,000/- (Fifteen Thousand only) per house, for upto 5000 houses in the State which were fully damaged due to Flood Disaster in Kerala.

The Member Secretary , KSDMA , as per letter read above, has informed that due to the exchange gain in US Dollar rate, the amount alloted per house for the implementation of GoI-UNDP programme on Enhancing Institutional and Community Resilience to Disaster and Climate Change has been increased to 16,500/- per house for 5000 families, and requested to amend the G.O read above accordingly .

In view of the above circumstances, Government are pleased to modify the amount alloted per house as per Government order read above i.e, Rs.15,000/-(Fifteen Thousand only) to Rs.16,500/- (Sixteen Thousand Five Hundred Only) per house as requested by the Member Secretary, KSDMA.
