The District Hospital, Kanhangad organized a one day training programme on emergency response and disaster management to the hospital staff and field level health workers. Two sessions were as part of the training. The first was about Disaster Management handled by Sri. Prem G Prakash, Hazard Analyst, DEOC, Kasaragod. He shared insights on hazard – vulnerability profile of Kasaragod district, health sector’s preparedness for disaster response, sources of early warning for various natural hazards, impacts of disasters on health sector, post-disaster diseases etc. The second session focused on effectively responding to emergencies in a hospital setting including fire and gas leaks. Sri. Pavithran P V, Station Officer, Fire and Rescue Station, Kanhangad was the resource person for the second session. A total of 55 participants (F-33, M-22) attended the training programme.
