#### **EVENT REPORT**



Kerala State - District Disaster Management Authorities, in collaboration with the District Fire Station, have organized International Disaster Risk Reduction Day celebration on Wednesday, October 23, 2024. The program was inaugurated by Regional Fire Officer P. Ranjith at the Kannur Fire Station. Welcome speech was delivered by Hazard Analyst S. Aiswarya. The Kannur District Fire Officer S.K. Bijumon presided over the session.

Following the inauguration, the top ten Aapada Mitra volunteers were awarded badges of honor and medals, recognizing their outstanding contributions to volunteer work in the district. Additionally, certificates were distributed to 93 Aapada Mitra volunteers in appreciation of their service. Fire Officer K. Harinarayan conducted an informative session on disaster management, discussing best practices and strategies for effective response and recovery.

The program concluded with a group discussion involving Aapada Mitra volunteers, fostering collaboration and sharing of ideas for future disaster management initiatives. LSG DM coordinator Thasleem Fazil expressed gratitude to all participants for making the event a success.

#### **Group Discussion**



The group discussion was the final session of the program. Many volunteers participated in the discussion without hesitation. Some provided suggestions, while others raised complaints. Here are the key points from the discussion:

- The communication process should be effective.
- Consider giving Aapada Mitra volunteers the same recognition as Civil Defence volunteers.
- A request to issue safety boots .
- There was a request to provide information about the locations of sirens.
- \* Their insurance has expired, so they want to know the updated status regarding it.
- They want the panchayat/municipality to recognize them as an integral part of disaster management, as many panchayats/municipalities do not consider them in any disaster management processes. Therefore, Aapada Mitra and Civil Defence should be included in the ERT group of the disaster management plan.
- Conduct school safety programs with Aapada Mitra volunteers.
- \* Request to conduct awareness classes on changing trends in disaster management.

Ensure that age criteria are being followed, as many people want to join Aapada Mitra. There are currently older individuals in the group, which is why younger individuals cannot join.
