ORDER

As per Government order read as 2nd paper above, Government has sanctioned the posts of Communication Engineer and Safety Engineer in KSDMA. Currently, the post of Communication Engineer comes under category IX and requires B.Tech Electronics and communication with minimum of 60% in qualifying exam and an Experience of minimum of 2 years, while the Safety Engineer position is under category X which requires B.Tech in Safety and Fire/Industrial/Chemical/Mechanical Engineering with minimum of 60% in qualifying exam and an experience of minimum of 2 years.

As per letter read as 3rd paper above, Commissioner, Disaster Management has recommended that the categorization of the Communication Engineer and Safety Engineer positions may be changed to Category XI to ensure a fair and uniform classification in line with the qualifications specified in the Government Order read as 1st paper above.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to re-categorize the posts of Communication Engineer (presently in Category IX) and Safety Engineer (presently in category X) in KSDMA, as Category XI of Government Order read as 1st paper

above.
