The Assam State Disaster Management Authority (ASDMA) organized a two-day *Youth Convention on Disaster Management* at Guwahati, Assam, on **10th and 11th December 2024**, under the theme "Empowering the Next Generation for a Resilient Future."

The event aimed to inspire and mobilize youth to actively engage in **disaster risk reduction** (**DRR**) and **response activities**, and to build a community of young leaders equipped with the knowledge, tools, and networks necessary to tackle the challenges posed by both natural and human-induced disasters.

Over 600 participants attended the convention, including District Disaster Management Officers (DDMOs), AAPDA Mitra volunteers, Women Cadres, Circle Quick Response Teams (CQRTs), and District Disaster Response Force (DDRF) members from across India.

The Kerala State Disaster Management Authority (KSDMA) was represented by Mr. Jayachandran, Chief Manager, and Mr. Fahad Marzook T. U., Hazard Analyst (Meteorology).

During the technical session on "State-level Innovations and Best Practices in Disaster Risk Reduction," Mr. Fahad Marzook delivered a 30-minute presentation on the best practices and innovative approaches adopted by Kerala in Disaster Management, highlighting:

- The multi-hazard preparedness and response framework of KSDMA,
- The integration of technology and community-based approaches in DRR, and
- The **KaWaCHaM Early Warning System**, developed by KSDMA for real-time weather and hazard communication up to local levels.

The presentation received wide appreciation from the participants and organizers for showcasing Kerala's **comprehensive and community-inclusive approach** to disaster management.

The event provided an excellent platform for inter-state knowledge exchange, youth engagement, and future collaboration opportunities between Kerala SDMA, ASDMA, and other state disaster management authorities.
