Details of the Event	<p>A Training of Trainers (ToT) on Preparation of School Suraksha Padhadhi was organized by the District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA), Palakkad, on 26.05.2025 at the Collectorate Conference Hall, Palakkad.</p> <p>The session focused on the steps and components involved in preparing School Safety Plans, covering both structural and non-structural safety measures, first aid and basic response training, awareness and preparedness activities, and the formation of School Disaster Management Clubs.</p> <p>The training aimed to build the capacity of participants to guide schools in developing practical and locally relevant safety plans. It also emphasized the importance of integrating safety measures into routine school activities to ensure preparedness among students and staff. Regular awareness sessions and mock drills were highlighted as essential tools to strengthen safety culture and improve overall readiness in schools.</p>
