Details of the event	On 14th October 2024, I conducted a seminar on Landslide Mitigation & Management at the College of Architecture, Trivandrum. During the session, I provided an in-depth overview of landslide hazards in Wayanad, explaining the geological and climatic factors that contribute to slope instability. I discussed the challenges in managing landslide-prone areas, including rapid urbanization, rainfall-induced soil saturation, and existing infrastructural vulnerabilities. I also highlighted strategies for risk mitigation, disaster preparedness, and community safety, using case studies from recent landslide events in the region. The students and faculty actively participated in discussions, asking questions about preventive measures, early warning systems, and ways to integrate disaster management principles into planning and architectural design. Through this seminar, I aimed to enhance their understanding of landslide risks and emphasize the importance of incorporating hazard mitigation into development planning, equipping future architects to make informed and resilient design decisions in landslide-prone areas.
