| Details of the Event | As part of the ongoing Living Lab initiatives, Kanichar Grama Panchayath, in collaboration with the Kerala State Disaster Management Authority (KSDMA), District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA) – Kannur, and the Tribal Department, successfully organized a comprehensive training program titled "Tribal Disaster Management Plan Preparation." |
| | The main aim of this initiative was to enhance the disaster preparedness and response capabilities of the tribal communities residing in the region. Recognizing the unique vulnerabilities and challenges faced by tribal populations during natural and man-made disasters, the program was designed to equip them with the necessary knowledge, skills, and tools to effectively anticipate, prepare for, and manage different types of disasters. |
| | Through interactive sessions, group discussions, and practical exercises, participants were introduced to the fundamentals of disaster risk reduction, community-based disaster management planning, and strategies for early warning, evacuation, and recovery. The training also encouraged community participation in creating localized disaster management plans that are culturally appropriate and sustainable. |
| | This initiative represents a significant step towards inclusive and community-led disaster resilience, ensuring that no group is left behind in the state's broader disaster preparedness efforts. |
