ORDER

As per the letter read as 1st paper above,the Member Secretary, KSDMA has submitted a proposal named "Bhadram- Hospital Safety plan" in all the districts of the State of Kerala. The project aims to enhance hospital safety and disaster resilience in Kerala's 1280 health facilities in the public sector, prioritizing safety and developing strong disaster management plans to ensure uninterrupted healthcare services during emergencies. To achieve this, a comprehensive Hospital Disaster Management plan orientation program will be conducted, providing training to one representative from each health facility. The total estimate for the proposal is ₹12,57,000/-.

2. As per the letter read as 2nd paper above, The proposal was placed before the State Executive Committee in the meeting held on 26/04/2025. The Committee agreed to sanction an amount of ₹12,57,000/- from the SDRF Preparedness and capacity Building window for hospital safety plan preparation.

3. Government have examined the matter in detail. It has been understood that the amount of Rs. 42,000/- mentioned under the 6th item in the estimate has been incorrectly recorded. In this context, the amount may be corrected to Rs. 28,000/- (14x2000), and by reducing Rs. 14,000/- from the total estimate of Rs. 12,57,000/-, an amount of **Rs. 12,43,000/-** (Twelve lakh fourty three thousand) may be sanctioned from the HoA **2245-02-101-94-01-Flood Other Items**, of SDRF Preparedness and

Capacity Building window to the SEOC Account No. **33031314643**, IFSC **SBIN0016083**, SBI, Maruthamkuzhy Branch, for hospital safety plan preparation.

4. Finance Officer, Disaster Management shall take necessary action to transfer credit the amount to the above SEOC account.
