Assembly Point signage was installed at EMS Mandiram, and Safe Shelter signage was installed at the Government Old Age Home. The Tsunami Information Board at Chaal Beach was inaugurated by Grama Panchayat President Shri. K. Sanil. The activity was completed with the active cooperation and participation of Grama Panchayat representatives, the KELTRON team, the LSGDM Plan Coordinator, Ward Members, and other stakeholders..
