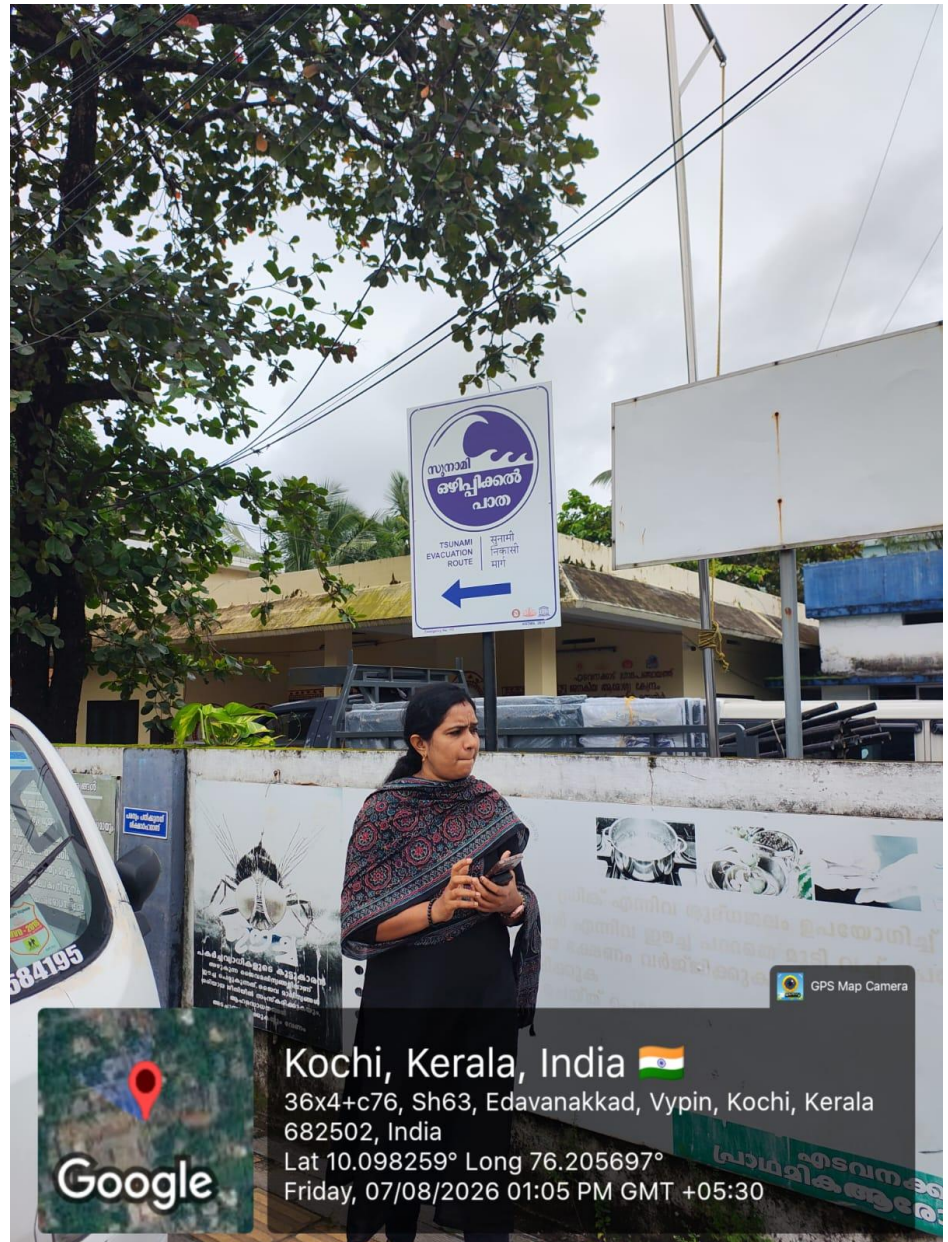
Details of the event	On 07th of August 2026, as part of the Tsunami Ready Programme, tsunami preparedness signboards were installed at three identified locations in Edavanakkad Grama Panchayat, Ernakulam. The programme was conducted from 11:30 AM to 4:00 PM and was attended by the Panchayat President, concerned Ward Member, Hazard Analyst and LSG Disaster Management Plan Coordinator. . A field-level verification of the proposed signboard locations was conducted. Based on the site verification, the sign board was installed at three locations, these included one Evacuation Route Board in front of F.H.C Edavanakkad, one Information Board at Aniyil Beach and one Assembly Point Board at S.P SABHA L.P School. The activity was aimed at strengthening tsunami preparedness at the community level by providing clear and easily identifiable information on evacuation routes, safe shelters, assembly points and tsunami-related preparedness measures.
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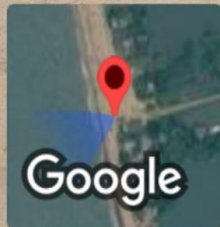

The joint participation of the Panchayat representatives and the LSG Disaster Management Plan Coordinator also contributed to improved local-level ownership of the Tsunami Ready initiative.
