Tsunami Ready Signage Installation at Chemancheri Grama Panchayat

Details of the Event	As part of the Tsunami Ready Programme, tsunami information, evacuation, assembly point and safe shelter signage were installed at various locations in Chemancheri Grama Panchayat on 05 August 2026. The installation was undertaken to strengthen tsunami preparedness, improve public awareness and facilitate safe evacuation of the coastal community during a tsunami emergency. The Tsunami Information Board (TIB) was installed at Kappad Beach. An Assembly Point Signage was installed at Bablu Park, in front of DTPC. Two Safe Evacuation Route Signages were installed to indicate designated evacuation routes. Safe Shelter Signages were installed at Thiruvangoor Higher Secondary School and Shadi Mahal. The inauguration of the tsunami signage boards was carried out by Smt. Subaida Kabeer, Vice President, Chemancheri Grama Panchayat. The signage installation activities were carried out under the leadership and coordination of Smt. Balkis Musthafa, Ward Member. The activity was completed with the active cooperation



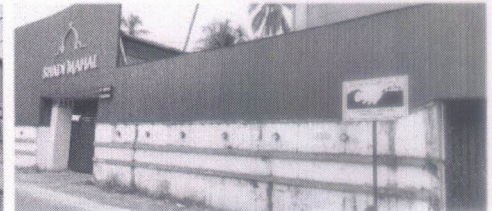
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	and participation of Grama Panchayat representatives, the KELTRON team, the LSGDM Plan Coordinator, Ward Members, and other stakeholders.

Output from the Event	A total of 6 tsunami preparedness signages were installed: 1 Tsunami Information Board at Kappad Beach; 1 Assembly Point Signage at Bablu Park, in front of DTPC Park; 2 Safe Evacuation Route Signages; and 2 Safe Shelter Signages at Thiruvangoor Higher Secondary School and Shadi Mahal. The activity enhanced public awareness regarding tsunami hazards, evacuation procedures and safe locations and strengthened community-level disaster preparedness.
