Conducted / Organised by	District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA), Kasaragod / Kerala State Disaster Management Authority (KSDMA), in coordination with Valiyaparamba Grama Panchayat; installation carried out by Keltron.
Details of the Event	As part of strengthening tsunami preparedness and disaster risk reduction measures in the coastal areas of Kasaragod District, tsunami-related information and evacuation signage boards were installed in Valiyaparamba Grama Panchayat on 3 August 2026 by Keltron. A Tsunami Information Board was installed at Mahmoodiya Madrasa. A Tsunami Shelter Location Board was installed at AUPS Kaithakkad. A Tsunami Assembly Point Board was installed at Mahmoodiya Madrasa. In addition, Evacuation Route Sign Boards were installed at three locations in Ward No. 14. The signage is intended to improve public awareness, clearly identify designated shelter and assembly locations, guide residents and visitors towards safe evacuation routes, and support timely and orderly evacuation during a tsunami or other coastal emergency. Mr. Ahammed Shafeeqe, LSG DM Plan Coordinator, participated in the programme as part of the activities of the District Disaster Management Authority. Mr. Manoj, Vice President of Valiyaparamba Grama Panchayat, also participated in the programme representing the Grama Panchayat.
