Details of the Event	On 06 August 2026, as part of the Tsunami Ready Programme, tsunami preparedness signboards were installed at five identified locations in Veliyancode Grama Panchayat, Malappuram. The programme was conducted from 11:30 AM to 4:00 PM and was attended by the Panchayat President, concerned Ward Member and LSG Disaster Management Plan Coordinator. The Panchayat President inaugurated the installation by unveiling the first Information Board placed in front of the Fisheries Dispensary. Prior to the installation, a discussion was conducted with the Panchayat representatives on 22 July 2026, followed by field-level verification of the proposed signboard locations. Based on the site verification, the sign board installed at five locations, these included two Evacuation Route Boards at identified junctions, one Information Board in front of the Fisheries Dispensary, one Shelter Board at Ayyottichira Palli, and one Assembly Point Board at GFLPS Veliyancode. The activity was aimed at strengthening tsunami preparedness at the community level by providing clear and easily identifiable information on evacuation routes,



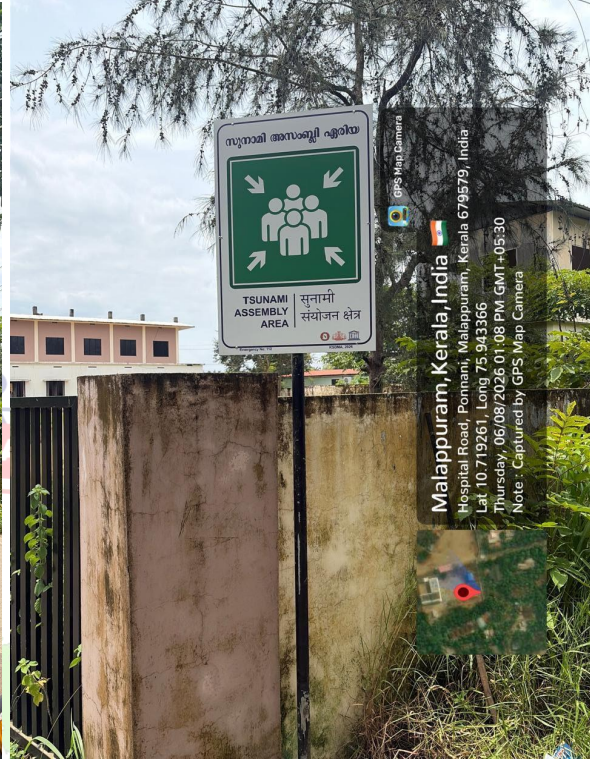
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	safe shelters, assembly points and tsunami-related preparedness measures

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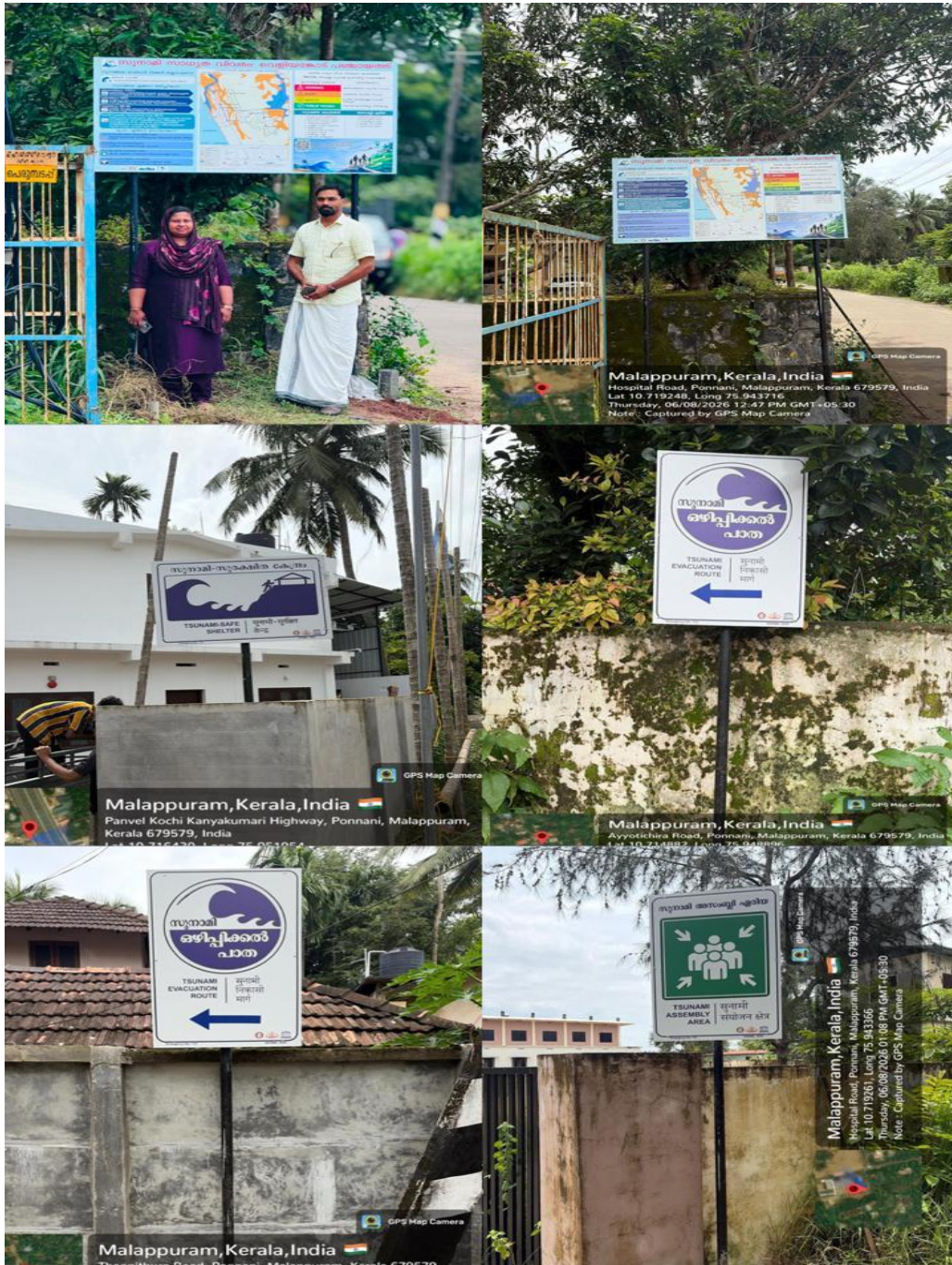
